Original Plat of Land District For Camp Osborn

The following is a scan of the plat of Land District 15 of Dooly County (now part of Worth County). The original is stored at the Georgia State Archive.

The plat was drawn upside down (north is to the bottom). Camp Osborn appears in the upper left corner of the plat and is outlined in black. Therefore, the Flint River is on the right side of the plat. The plat was not reversed in scanning as the writing is not reversed. I have no information as to why this land district plat was drawn upside down.

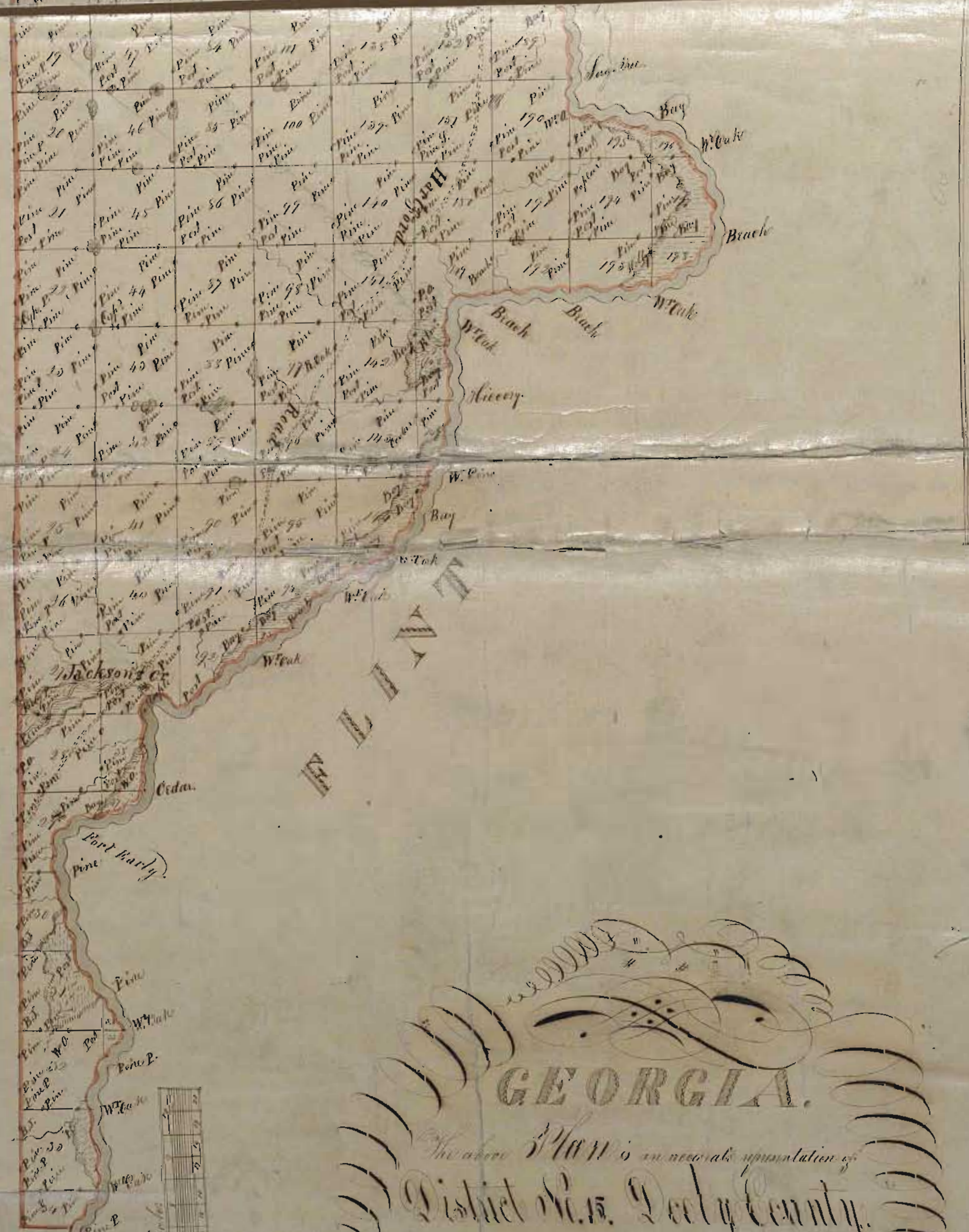
